Two professionally adjudicated levels of the Berkley-Pendell participation are rewarded with placements and rewards.

A maximum performance experience is supported. The Celebratory Concert will feature the 1st, 2nd place and Honourable Mention Awardees of the Competition Level and the Judges' selected pianists of the Festival Level.

Repertoire requirements in both Levels include the presentation of two memorized works, fulfilling the following designations: Competition Level:

Divisions:

Elementary 1: Grade 5

Two repertoire selections equivalent to AiM 4-7 (repertoire not necessary from AiM list), no sonatina required, repertoire must demonstrate contrasting styles and tempi

Elementary 2: Grade 5

Two repertoire selections equivalent to AiM 7-9 (repertoire not necessary from AiM list), no sonatina required, repertoire must demonstrate contrasting styles and tempi

Junior 1: Grades 6-7

Two repertoire selections equivalent to AiM 8-10, repertoire must consist of one movement (first or last) of a classical period <u>sonata or sonatina</u>, plus a composition of contrasting style and tempi

Junior 2: Grades 8-9

Two repertoire selections equivalent to AiM 9-11, repertoire must consist of one movement (first or last) of a classical period <u>sonata or sonatina</u>, plus a composition of contrasting style and tempi

Senior: Grades 10, 11, 12

Two repertoire selections equivalent to AiM 10-12, repertoire must consist of one movement (first or last) of a classical period sonata or sonatina, plus a composition of contrasting style and tempi

Monetary Awards are presented in all Divisions for 1st place and 2nd place. Honourable Mentions will also be named. In addition, all pianists will receive a certificate of participation and a medal.

Festival Level:

Divisions:

Elementary 1: Grade 5

Two repertoire selections equivalent to AiM 4-6 (repertoire not necessary from AiM list), repertoire must demonstrate contrasting styles and tempi

Elementary 2: Grade 5

Two repertoire selections equivalent to AiM 5-7 (repertoire not necessary from AiM list), repertoire must demonstrate contrasting styles and tempi

Junior 1: Grades 6-7

Two repertoire selections equivalent to AiM 6-8 (repertoire not necessary from AiM list), repertoire must demonstrate contrasting styles and tempi

Junior 2: Grades 8-9

Two repertoire selections equivalent to AiM 7-10 (repertoire not necessary from AiM list), repertoire must demonstrate contrasting styles and tempi

Senior: Grades 10, 11, 12

Two repertoire selections equivalent to AiM 10-12 (repertoire not necessary from AiM list), repertoire must demonstrate contrasting styles and tempi

Judges will select participants of the Divisions to be included in the Celebratory Recital. In addition, all pianists will receive a certificate of participation and a medal.
